Key characteristics

We are a bible based church who love Jesus and we are keen to connect the Bible to modern life issues whilst being engaging and open to all. We are looking to employ those who hold the same values.

The church is in the position to build a new team, as explained further in our church profile attached. Children/Youth (and their families) is one of three ministry streams we foresee. This role could be as part of the ministry stream or with responsibility of leading this ministry stream. Additionally, it is our expectation is that one stream lead, to be discerned, will have an additional responsibility to act as a team leader. This role will carry the title of Lead Minister but would not extend to active management of the other ministries which would remain the responsibility of those appointed to lead them.
